Eveline Ruby Roy Age 94, passed away on Sunday, March 31, 2019 at The Knolls of Oxford. She was born on July 3, 1924 in Hilltop West Bromich, England the youngest of seven children. While growing up in England she was very active in sports and dance. Her dance team would travel to entertain the British troops. She had been given a full scholarship to attend a Dress Designing School when WWII broke out. Living in a bomb shelter for six years she made gun sites for the Royal Airforce Bombers while working for Staffordshire Printing. It was during this time that she met her future husband, Sgt. Leo Roy. They wed on July 14, 1945 in West Bromich, England. Two of their four children were born in England. After two weeks at sea she disembarked the SS Marine Flasher with two small children as she came to her new home in the United States where they were blessed with two additional children. She managed several restaurants and hotels before going into sales at the Butler County Memorial Park. She loved going to the beach, dancing, boating, fishing and spending time with her friends at the camp ground playing bingo and singing Karaoke. She is survived by her children, Roger (Liz), Jacqui Campbell (Lonnie), Donna Brinkman and Jamie (Jackie), thirteen grandchildren and eighteen great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband Leo of 36 years, her loyal companion of 20+ years, Herman Baker, her parents and a grandson.
