Albert William Francis age 92, of Hamilton died Thursday, May 2, 2013 at his residence at Westover Retirement Community. He was born in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada on November 9, 1920, the son of Oscar and Martha (Smith) Francis. He attended Central Missouri State Teacher's College and was a veteran of the U. S. Navy serving from June 9, 1942 to October 11, 1945. He married Dorothy Zoller in Hamilton on October 31, 1942.
