



## Alfred C. Woedl

August 2, 1921 - February 4, 2021

Alfred Conrad Woedl, of Hamilton passed away peacefully on February 4, 2021 at the age of 99. He was born August 2, 1921 in Gostyn, Poland (formerly Germany) to Michael and Rose Woedl and traveled with his parents and older brother to the United States when he was one year old. He was a lifelong resident of Hamilton, Ohio and graduated from Hamilton High School in 1940 where he was a proud member of the state championship football team.
