Alson (Al) Baker, a Hamilton resident, died on June 19, 2012 at Golden Years Nursing Center at age 84. Mr. Baker was born on November 19, 1927 in Hamilton, Ohio, the son of Burt and Linda Jane Baker. On June 7, 1952, he was married to Janet Ann Wynn in St. Peter in Chains Church in Hamilton.
