Arnold HORNSBY, Age 87, of Hamilton, died Tuesday, January 23, 2007 at 12:40 p.m. in Ft. Hamilton Hospital Vitas Hospice Unit. He was born October 25, 1919 in Clay County, Kentucky the son of Ellie and Charlotte (Brock) Hornsby. He served in the United States Marine Corp from 1940 to 1945 in the South Pacific. He married Caroline Cornett on January 20, 1954 in Connersville, Indiana. Mr. Hornsby was employed as a Metal Assembler by Fisher Body for thirty years retiring in 1977. For years he raised and trained beagles for field trials. He developed his own line for show and was recognized throughout the country.
