January 3, 1933 - March 21, 2021

Barbara Joan Huston age 88 of Fairfield passed away Sunday, March 21, 2021 at Bradford Place. She was born on January 3, 1933 in Halifax, Nova Scotia, the daughter of Frederick and Dorothy (Moreland) Creighton, one of seven children. 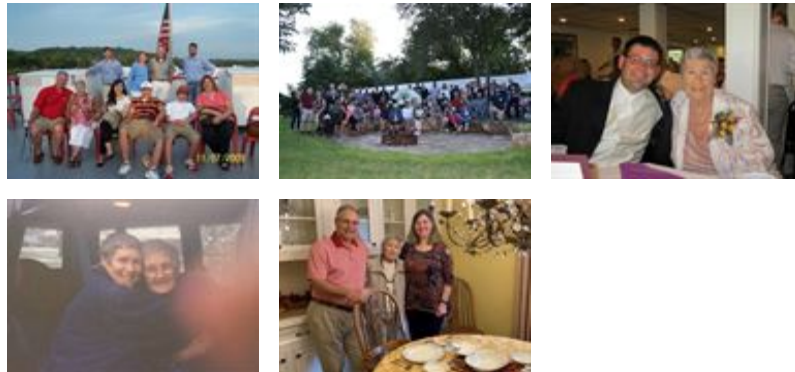
