



Cara "Jay" Calvert

July 24, 1923 - November 15, 2015

Cara J. "Jay" Calvert age 92 of Hamilton, passed away peacefully on Sunday, November 15, 2015 at home. He was born July 24, 1923 in Poplar Plains, KY to Erastus and Inez Hamilton Calvert. After graduating from high school in 1941, Jay proudly served in the Army Air Corps during World War II. He worked for Proctor & Gamble following his military discharge. He was active in the Boy Scouts of America serving both as troop leader and merit badge counselor, and was honored with the Silver Beaver Award for Distinguished Service to Boy Hood in 1961. Following retirement, Jay attended seminary and was ordained as a deacon in the Episcopal Church. He served the Church in several local parishes, and as a missionary to Nigeria, the Windward Islands and Alaska. Jay was a member of VFW Post 670 where he served as chaplain, and of the Disabled American Veterans Ch. 15 where he was an active participant in the Partners in Prime veterans discussion group. He is survived by his five daughters Kay Calvert of Liberty, IN; Julie (John) Bhend of Harrisville, MI; Libby Calvert of Las Vegas, NV; Sheila Kawakami of Honolulu, HI; and JoAnn (Howard) Landsaw of Hamilton, OH; 13 grandchildren; and 11 great-grandchildren. A memorial service to celebrate Jay's life will be held at Trinity Episcopal Church, 115 N. Sixth Street on Saturday, November 21, 2015 at 11:00 AM, followed by a light luncheon in the Church Parish Hall. All those whose lives Jay touched are welcome to attend.
