Carol then finished her career working as an Education Consultant at Hamilton County Educational Service Center 1996 – 2005. She then retired in 2005. 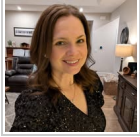

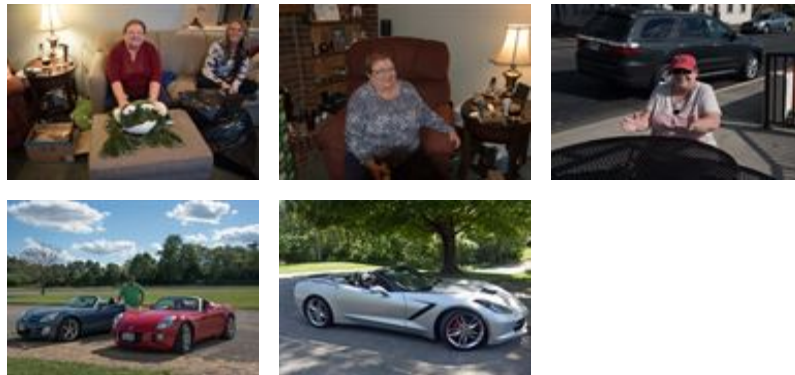
