Charles L. GAULT, age 83 a resident of Garden Manor Retirement Home died Friday, November 19, 2004 at 7:15 a.m. at Garden Manor. He was born in St. Clair Township on December 12, 1920, the son of William and Mary Anna (Schueler) Gault. He was a veteran of WWII serving in the US Army from July 20, 1942 thru January 2, 1946, attaining the rank of Sergeant. On December 20, 1941, he married Viola M. Coning in Seven Mile.
