Clifford C. SCARBOROUGH, Age 88, a resident of Fairfield died Thursday, September 20, 2007 in Mercy Hospital, Fairfield. He was born September 1, 1919 in Hamilton the son of Clifford and Lela (Cooke) Scarborough. He was a Hamilton High School graduate and attended the University of Cincinnati. He was a veteran of the U. S. Army serving as a pilot with the Army Air Corps from 1942 to 1945. He graduated from Aviation Cadet School and was assigned to troop carrier command. He piloted C-47 aircraft in the European Theater, the Holland Invasion, Battle of the Bulge and the re-supply of the 101st Airborne at Bastogne. He married Lois Gilley on January 31, 1941 in Hamilton and she preceded him in death May 18, 1992. He had owned a State Auto Insurance Agency in Hamilton for 41 years, retiring January 1, 1987. He was a member of Redeemer Church and the American Legion. He is survived by his daughter, Sue Ann Koster and husband, Richard of Cincinnati; a brother Paul G. Scarborough and wife Jean of Hamilton; a sister, Vera Grissom of Oxford; two grandchildren, Daniel Keith and wife, Kim of Mason, Ohio and Ryan Koster and wife, Alisa of Blue Ash, Ohio and four great grandchildren, Alex, Emily, Marisa and Mia.
