Donna Mae Coombe, age 80, passed away on Saturday, May 9, 2026. Donna was born in Shenandoah, Pennsylvania on June 6, 1945, the eldest child of Albert W. and Elizabeth (Roberts) Kieres. She was married to William Coombe on October 4, 1975, until his passing in 2022. Donna was a member of First United Methodist Church in Hamilton. She was a 1963 graduate of Mahanoy Area High School in Mahanoy City, PA and a 1975 graduate of the Schuylkill County Practical Nurses Program, qualifying her to become a Licensed Practical Nurse. Then, in 1984, Donna graduated from Allegheny Community College and became a Registered Nurse. Accompanying her husband's career transfers, Donna worked as a nurse in 3 different states. Her most recent position was in the psychiatric unit at Fort Hamilton Hospital, where she served as an RN for 33 years, until her retirement. Donna is survived by her children, Lawrence Coombe and Kara Tegge (husband Rob), of Hamilton, and Donna-lyn Coombe of Cincinnati, 7 grandchildren: Russell Coombe, Jessica Rice (husband Jared), Julia, Jenna and Jada Tegge, and Helpful and Clara Braun, brother Albert W.
