



## Dr. Joseph C. Toman III

Dr. Joseph C. Toman III, age 79, passed away at home Sunday, December 21, 2014 surrounded by his family. He was preceded in death by his parents, Catherine and Joseph Toman II, and stepmother Dorothea Jacobs Toman. He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Judith Toman, children, Catherine Hackett (Bruce), Jayne Ernstberger (Hugh) and Joseph C. Toman IV (Lori); granddaughters, Amanda and Alyson Ernstberger, Aubrey Hackett, and Emma, Lily and Sophie Toman; sister, Dr. Nancy Toman Baldwin (Fletcher), brother, Thomas E. He later returned to Tri-State College for a brief period as a professor of aeronautical engineering and then, following in his father's footsteps, studied at Palmer College of Chiropractic, graduating in 1963 with a Doctorate in Chiropractic. Joseph returned to Hamilton and joined his father in practice at 225 Main St. He maintained his chiropractic practice there for 50 years where he was dedicated to the natural care and wellbeing of his many patients. Joseph served on the board of the YMCA Camp Campbell Gard, was a member of the Toastmasters, Elks Lodge #93, and was proud to be a 40 year member of

the Lindenwald Kiwanis Club. He was an accomplished carpenter, handyman and gardener. He enjoyed his friends from Couples Club and passionately played tennis and golf.
