



Dr. Pacifico C. Amaro

January 2, 1927 - December 16, 2015

Age 88, of Hamilton, died Wednesday, December 16, 2015 at his residence. He was born on January 2, 1927 in Victoria Tarlac, Philippines the son of Silverio and Calixta (Catabay) Amaro. He married Catalina Reyes on August 8, 1956 in the Philippines. He graduated from the University of Santo Tomas with a Medical degree. He served his residency in Elyria Memorial Hospital and became a family physician. Dr. Amaro came to Ohio and began to practice in Hamilton and Fairfield in 1968. He retired in 1997 after thirty three years of faithful practice. He was an active member of St. Peter in Chains Roman Catholic Church, the Butler County Medical Association and also served as a Family Practice Diplomate. He is survived by his wife Catalina; son Pacifico Amaro Jr. (Zenaida) of Hamilton, and daughter Cathleen Amaro, of Crestview Hills, Kentucky; grandchildren, Michael, Patrick, Catherine, Peter, Paul (Lauren), Anna, Joe, Sarah, and John, and great grandchild Landrie.
