November 7, 1935 - December 16, 2021

Edna Ruth Wirtley, age 86 of Middletown, died Thursday, December 16, 2021 at McCullough-Hyde Hospital after a more than 20 year battle with Parkinson's disease. 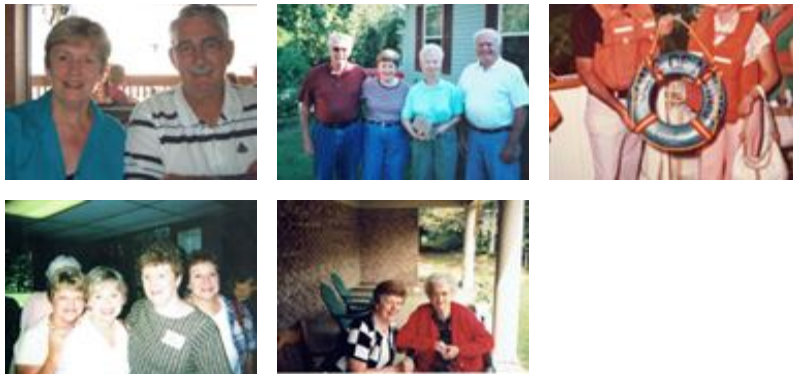
