Edna Lorene ZELLNER, Age 83, of Findlay, Ohio, formerly of Hamilton, died Monday, August 22, 2005 at 4:25 p.m. in Sunrise Assisted Living, Findlay. She was born August 12, 1922 in Corbin, Kentucky, the daughter of Luther and Pina (Tuggle) Sharp. She was a graduate of Hamilton High School. She married Raymond Zellner in Hamilton on April 23, 1947 and he preceded her in death in 1987. She had been employed as a secretary for Champion Papers, retiring in 1960. In 1993 Edna received the Greater Hamilton Women's Bowling Association Hall of Fame - Member of the year award. She was awarded a Life membership in the Greater Hamilton Women's Bowling Association and a Life membership in the Women's International Bowling Congress. She was the Greater Hamilton Women's Bowling Association Secretary from 1978 to 1990 and served on the Board of Directors. She was instrumental in forming the Greater Hamilton Bowling Council and served as secretary for this organization. Edna was also deeply involved with AJBC-YABA serving on the Board of Directors as secretary for many years. Edna was also an avid collector of dolls, figurines, plates, coins and stamps; and was a lifelong fan of the Cincinnati Reds. She was a member of the Hamilton Elks Auxiliary. She is survived by her son, Jim Zellner and wife Cathy of Findlay; her sister, Evelyn Fuersich and husband, Paul of Bradenton, Florida and two grandsons, Jeff Zellner and Greg Zellner. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, a brother, Jim Sharp and a sister, Beulah Pauline Sharp. Funeral services will be held Friday, August 26, 2005 at 10

a.m. at Weigel Funeral Home, 980 N. W. Washington Blvd. with Rev. Edwin Beck officiating. Burial will be in Greenwood Cemetery.
