George R. Michaels Age 94, of Hamilton, passed away Saturday, April 22, 2017. He was born in Bayonne, New Jersey on November 11, 1922 the son of John and Ruth Mary (Rickert) Michaels. George graduated from Cornell University with a degree in engineering, and served his country with honor during WWII in the U. S. Navy as a Lieutenant JG on a command vessel in the Pacific. On September 13, 1944 he was united in marriage to Mary Ellen Schwing in Bay City, Michigan and she preceded him in death. He retired as co-owner, with his wife, from Shelly Blacktopping. George enjoyed spending time with his family, loved golfing, was a member of Rotary Club, Lindenwald Kiwanis, The Central YMCA and was a charter member of Westwood Presbyterian Church. He was instrumental in starting Westwood in 1958 and donated much of his time there. 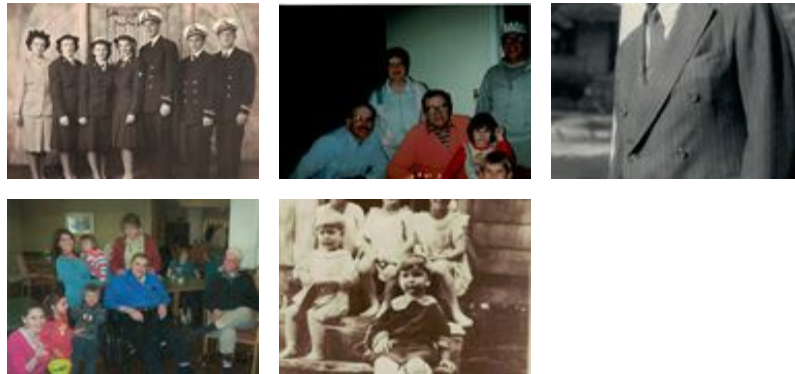
