Gordon K. Chambers, Age 89, of Hamilton, died Sunday, June 29, 2008 at 11:08 p.m. in Golden Years Retirement Community. He was born August 16, 1918 in Highland Park, Michigan, the son of Gordon C. and Viola (Minnich) Chambers. He served in the United States Air Force from 1942 to 1946 during WWII.
