Harold N. Leppert age 85, of Hamilton, died Thursday, February 26, 2015 in Fort Hamilton Hospital. He was born on June 29, 1929 in Mansfield, Ohio the son of Harold F. and Louise (Weber) Leppert. Harold was a veteran of the U. S. Army serving from January 11, 1951 to October 14, 1952. He married Shirley M. Robinson on October 14, 1950 and she preceded him in death March 17, 2004. He is survived by two sons, Greg Leppert, Hamilton and David (Patty) Leppert, Boise, Idaho and his sister, Joanne Baumberger, Mansfield.
