Herbert G. Hood, age 91, Fairfield, passed away at Westover Retirement Community on Sunday August 11, 2019. He was born on July 20, 1928 in Lima, Ohio the son of the late Oren and Venita (Featheringill) Hood. He was a 1947 graduate of Delta High School and attended Cedarville University. He was a veteran of the U. S. Army serving during the Korean Era Conflict. Throughout his high school and college years sports were a huge part of life. Herb dedicated much of his time and energy to his love of sports. He was a passionate varsity athlete participating in multiple sports. On November 8, 1952 he married PatsyD Irwin in Delta, Ohio and she preceded him in death on December 14, 2007. Herb was employed as the head of security for Hamilton Tool, retiring after many years of service.
