Jack BINNION, Age 82 a resident of Otterbein Home, Lebanon, Ohio died Thursday, March 8, 2007 at his residence. He was born February 12, 1925 in Scottsville, Kentucky the son of Jack and Ruth (Marsh) Binnion. He was a six year veteran of WWII, serving in the U.S. Army in the Pacific Theater.
