Jack C. Kraft, age 78, of Oxford passed away on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, at Bethesda North Hospital Cincinnati. Jack was born in Hamilton, the son of Jack and Margaret (Johanson) Kraft. He was a graduate of Taft High School, attended the University of Wittenburg while in the service and continued at the University of Cincinnati. He married Marcia Fike on June 15, 1968, in Hamilton.
