Age 93, of Hamilton died Monday, March 26, 2012 at 7 a.m. in Hospice of Hamilton. He was born in Middletown on August 4, 1918, the son of Charles D. and Sadie M. (Garrison) Hixson. He was a 1937 graduate of Middletown High School and a WWII veteran of the U S Navy serving from June 9, 1942 to December 14, 1945. He served in the Pacific Theater aboard the USS Allen and the USS Mack, as a machinist mate. He married Eva Grady on May 17, 1947 in Fort Wayne, Indiana. He retired as supervisor of steel manufacturing at Armco Steel, Inc. in 1976 after 35 years of service.
