Jack Singleton Age 83, passed away Tuesday, May 30, 2017 at the Kindred Hospital in Rome, Georgia due to sudden illness. He was born in Hamilton on October 3, 1933, the son of Hubert and Mildred (Brigmon) Singleton. He was raised in Hamilton and was at Hamilton High School when in 1951 he left to serve in the U.S. Navy receiving an honorable discharge in 1954. Jack was preceded in death by his parents, a dear younger brother, Michael Singleton, two beloved sisters, Susan Hawkins and Penny McHenry and his nephew Robbie Hawkins. He is survived by a friend and brother-in-law, Robert Hawkins and his daughter Becci Hawkins. Jack and wife, Orilene moved from Naples, Florida to Ellijay, Georgia.
