James E. LINDBLOOM, Age 79 of Indian Springs, died Saturday, July 9, 2005 at 2:40 p.m. in the University of Cincinnati Hospital. He was born April 9, 1926 in Detroit, Michigan the son of Everett and Margaret (Abraham) Lindbloom and attended Wayne State University. He served in the Army Air Corps from June 10, 1943 to December 13, 1945. He married Dorothy Hinkle on February 4, 1950 in Detroit. He was employed by Ohio Casualty Insurance Company, serving as Claims Manager in Springfield, Illinois and Hamilton for over 30 years, retiring in 1992.
