JEAN E. WRIGHT, Age 82, of Hamilton, died Saturday, September 22, 2007 in Ft. Hamilton Hospital. She was born March 8, 1925 in Mt. Gilead, Ohio. She married James Hoon, Sr. and he preceded her in death. She married Raymond W. Wright in December 1952 in Hamilton and he preceded her in death October 10, 1993. She had been employed as Executive Secretary to the Plant Manager of Clearing Machine Corporation, Sales Assistant-Projects, Building Division, Pease Company and Manager of the John Stahl Music Store. Jean had served as co-accompanist with William Jenne for the Camerata Singers, a volunteer at the Miami University Art Museum, Chairman of the Community Advisory Board at WMUB Radio, Oxford, Music Director for six Rotary Revel Productions, one of the founders and a board member of the Little Chicago Jazz Society, a lifetime member of National Federation of Music Clubs, Executive Director of Hamilton-Fairfield Arts Association for ten years, recipient of "Ambassador for the Arts" - 1997 and was an organist for several churches, most recently at her home church, Park Avenue United Methodist Church. She is survived by three sons, James E. Hoon of New York City, Richard R. Wright of McHenry, Illinois and Wade S. Wright and wife, MaryJo of Toledo, Ohio; two grandsons, Joshua Wright and Jeremy Wright; a brother, Richard McGaughy, a niece Ellen McGaughy and a nephew, David McGaughy all of Iowa.
