Johanna Hawkins Fenimore, of Hamilton, passed away on Saturday, March 23, 2024 at her home at the age of 75. She was born in Burbank, CA, on June 2, 1948, the daughter of Charles John and Margaret (Allen) Hawkins. Johanna graduated from Northwestern University with a bachelor's degree in Journalism in 1970. After college she moved to NYC and worked in Advertising. She began as a secretary and rose to be a copy writer at Ted Bates Agency and then at FCB. Johanna had a lifelong love of words, eventually creating crossword puzzles that appeared in the New York Times. After New York, she returned to California where she worked in sales at a company that sold flags for golf courses around the world. During this time she supported her aging parents.
