



## John R. Staley

Age 74, of Hamilton, died Friday, March 21, 2008 at 11:35 p.m. in Hospice of Hamilton at Sunrise. He was born December 23, 1933 in Sheridan, Indiana, the son of Raymond and Ruth (Leach) Staley. He was a graduate of Indiana University with a degree in Slavic Languages. He served in West Germany with the U. S. Air Force Communications/Intelligence Division during the Cold War from 1952-1956 attaining the rank of Staff Sergeant. He married Nancy Gwaltney in 1966 in Alexandria, Virginia. He was employed as a FBI Special Agent of the Department of Justice, serving in the Counter Intelligence Division for 12 years. In 1971 he began his career at Westinghouse in the International Division, working as a Government Relations/Power Project Development Specialist. While working for Westinghouse he lived in many countries overseas retiring in 1993 after 22 years. He is survived by his wife, Nancy; a son, John Richard Staley, Jr. of Alexandria, Virginia and a sister, Phyllis Walker and husband, Karl of Indianapolis, Indiana. He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Eugene Staley. Funeral services will be held Wednesday, March 26, 2008 at 2 p.m. at Weigel Funeral Home, 980 N. W.
