James William "JW" Day age 41, was born on October 5, 1974 in Hamilton and passed away July 12, 2016 due to a pulmonary embolism. JW was a loving father, brother, son, uncle, nephew and friend. He attended Wayne Elementary while living in Seven Mile. In 1985 he and his family moved to Lake St. Louis, Missouri and he attended Wentzville High School.
