Laurence Eugene Horne, 89, passed away peacefully on February 7 2025, in Hamilton, Ohio.

Laurence (Larry) was born on July 25, 1935 in Detroit, Michigan to Loretta Lane Horne and Laurence Eugene (Gene) Horne. He grew up in Detroit and Allen Park, Michigan, and spent many happy summers at the family cottage in Amherstburg, Ontario. Larry attended the University of Detroit where he received his Bachelor of Science and Doctor of Dental Surgery degrees. In 1962 Larry joined the U.S. Air Force. While serving at Lackland Air Force base in San Antonio, Texas he met Jayne Seymour. They married in 1965 and moved to Michigan where Larry partnered in a dental practice in Hazel Park for over 33 years. Larry and Jayne raised their three daughters in Birmingham, Michigan where they made wonderful life-long friends and enjoyed neighborhood parties, golf outings, summer vacations, and cheering on Michigan football.

In 1998 Larry and Jayne retired to Keowee Key, South Carolina. There they embraced lake living, hiking in the Blue Ridge Mountains and of course golfing. In 2017 they moved to Hamilton, Ohio where Larry was a loving “Dupoo” to his beloved grandsons Benjamin and Luke, often spectating at their sporting events and frequently providing bits of trivia and words of wisdom.

He always had a good (or bad) joke ready and loved to comment that his personal daily mantra was "I'm a very lucky man".

In addition to his parents, Larry was preceded in death by his wife of 56 years, Jayne, and his brothers, David Horne and Robert Horne.

Larry is survived by his daughters, Andrea Denton (David) of Charlottesville, VA, Heather McGlennen (Norman) of Ann Arbor, MI, Elizabeth Fiehrer (Todd) of Liberty Township, OH, and grandsons Benjamin and Luke Fiehrer. He also leaves numerous friends so close they were considered family.
