Lawrence Owen Wheeler Age 91, a resident of Berkeley Square died Friday, June 25, 2010 at 2:10 a.m. in Fort Hamilton Hospital. He was born December 19, 1918 in Brookline, Massachusetts, the son of the late Harold and Rachel (Owen) Wheeler. A graduate of Bates College in Lewiston, Maine, Lawrence received his MBA from The Harvard School of Business and served in the U. S. Navy as a Lt. Commander during WWII from 1941 to 1946. He married Adela Wilson on November 27, 1948 in Hamilton. He was a 25 year executive in the folding carton business and owner/operator of Portland Printing in Portland, Maine for ten years. A member of Trinity Episcopal Church, Lawrence was a devoted family man and an avid jogger and swimmer. He was a founding member of the New London Hills Club. He was preceded in death by a brother, Paul Wheeler in 2003.
