Marilyn "Petie" Milders MURPHY, Age 80, of Hamilton, died Saturday, April 14, 2007 at her residence. She was born in Hamilton on March 21, 1927, daughter of Raymond "Cy" and Margaret (Doellman) Milders. She was a 1944 graduate of Hamilton High School and attended Miami University for two years.
