Mary Ann Young, age 86, passed away Sunday, June 14, 2026. She was born December 31, 1939 in Pineville, KY to the late Walter and Rose (Johnson) Hubbard. She married the love of her life, Orvel Young, Sr., in Jonesville, VA on February 25, 1961, and together they built a family rooted in love, faith, and selfless devotion.

To know Mary was to know grace in its purest form. She bore life’s difficulties with remarkable patience and rarely uttered a word of complaint, choosing instead to pour every ounce of herself into the people she loved.

Mary was a devoted and lifelong member of her church, where her faith was not simply practiced on Sundays but lived out every single day. She believed deeply, trusted completely, and let that faith guide everything she did.

She had a particular and boundless love for children. Whether they were her own, her grandchildren, her great-grandchildren, or children she encountered beyond her family’s doorstep, Mary lit up in their presence. She gave to them freely and joyfully — her time, her resources, her heart — right up until her final days. For decades she cleaned the homes of others, quiet and dignified work that she performed not for recognition, but to provide for her family and extend a helping hand to those around her, including her beloved sister Ina.

Mary is survived by her husband of 65 years, Orvel Young, Sr.; her three

She was also survived by many other family members and friends whose lives she touched in ways large and small.
