Myron E. Dudley, Age 81, of Hamilton died Saturday, July 26, 2008 at 1:10 a.m. in Fort Hamilton Hospital. He was born in Hamilton on October 27, 1926, the son of Jesse and Ethel (Waggoner) Dudley.
