Paul G. SCARBOROUGH, Age 81, of Fairfield Township, died Thursday, October 11, 2007, in Hospice of Hamilton at Sunrise. He was born in Hamilton on July 28, 1926, the son of Clifford, Sr. and Lela R. (Cooke) Scarborough. He was a 1947 graduate of Ross High School. He received a B. S. Degree in Education in 1950 and a M. S. Degree in History and Government in 1955 both from Miami University.
