



Pauline Wall Rogers

March 12, 1930 - January 9, 2016

Pauline Wall Rogers Age 85, of Hamilton, Ohio passed peacefully from this life after a brief illness on January 9, 2016, at Hospice of Hamilton. She was born on March 12, 1930 in Dayton, Ohio to the late Truman J. and Eve (Mitchell) Wall, but moved to Clearfield County, Pennsylvania where she spent her childhood. A typical one-room country school offered the first eight years of her education after which the family moved back to Dayton, Ohio where they owned and operated a local pharmacy. "Polly" graduated from Stivers High School in Dayton in 1946 and from Western College for Women (now part of Miami University), Oxford, Ohio in 1950. After 30 years of teaching in Hamilton and Fairfield Schools she retired and became a lifetime member of the Butler County Retired Teachers Association and the Ohio Retired Teachers Association. Mrs. Rogers was a lifelong member of the West Branch Quaker Meeting, Grampian, PA and became a member of the Trenton Mennonite Church in Trenton, Ohio. She was a member of the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution (D.A.R.) and the Colonial Dames XVII Century and the Penn Grange in Grampian, PA. She was preceded in death by her husband, Clarence W. "Babe" Rogers, her parents and two infant brothers. She is survived by her sister, Ruthann W. Neal, Hamilton, Ohio; two children, Sarah Ruth Rogers of Fripp Island, SC and William C. "Bill" Rogers, D.D.S., Hamilton; three grandchildren, Jennifer Rogers (Dr. Philip) Bradford, Raleigh, NC, Julie Elizabeth Rogers, Centerville, Ohio and Beth Ellen Rogers currently a student at Ohio State University and

two great granddaughters, Charlotte Clare Bradford, age 3 and Emily Grace Bradford, age 1 of Raleigh, NC. Funeral services will be held Tuesday, January 12, 2016 at 3:00 p.m. at the Trenton Mennonite Church, 2 E. Main Street, Trenton, Ohio with Pastor Ron Wenzel officiating. Burial will be in the Trenton Mennonite Cemetery.
