Ralph Shearer, born Dec. 30, 1928 to the parents of Vernon and Amanda (Riley) Shearer, died April 23, 2017 at Fort Hamilton Hospital. Ralph served in the U. S. Army in the Korean War (1950-1952). He received the Korean Service Medal & the United Nations Service Medal. He was employed by Pillsbury Mills for 25 years, Leshner Textiles for 10 years and First National Bank for 8 years. An avid bowler, Ralph was a sports enthusiast, loving the Cincinnati Reds, Cincinnati Bengals, and Cleveland Cavaliers with LeBron James. Ralph loved to travel, especially to the Smokies, Gatlinburg and Florida. A devout Christian, he was a member of First Baptist Church.
