Raymond K. Dawson Age 85, of Hamilton, passed away June 28, 2016. Born in Hamilton in 1930, he served in the U. S. Army during the Korean Conflict. In 1954, he married Marilyn Ullrey, who preceded him in death. A graduate of Miami University, he worked for 12 years at Black Clawson Co., achieving the position of manager of industrial sales. He then went into the insurance business, retiring as president of Great Miami Insurance Co.
