



Rev. Dr. Jerry Livingston

March 14, 1937 - August 3, 2015

Rev. Dr. Jerry Livingston age 78, of the Masonic Home in Springfield, Ohio, formerly of Hamilton, died Monday, August 3, 2015 at Mt. Pleasant Retirement Village, Monroe. He was born March 14, 1937 in Troy, Ohio the son of John and Chloe (Miller) Livingston. He was a 1955 graduate of Troy High School, attended Bangor Seminary in Bangor, Maine and graduated in 1971 with a B.A. and received a Masters of Divinity in Theology in 1973. Jerry received his Doctorates in Ministry/Psychology in 1981 from Eden Theology Seminary in Webster Groves, Missouri. He served in the U. S. Air National Guard and Reserve of the U. S. Air Force from 1955 – 1963. He married Caroline L. Rehmert on April 27, 1957 and she preceded him in death on September 1, 1988. He married Linda Golle in 1994 and she preceded him in death in July 2012. He ministered two churches in Maine, and two in Ohio, North Hampton United Church of Christ and Redeemer United Church of Christ where he served 18 years. He served as Director of Hamilton Community's Pastoral Care and Counseling Service and was past President of Hamilton Ministerial Association. He is survived by five daughters, Theresa Case, Goose Creek, South Carolina; Karen (Dennis) Tatum, Oak Ridge, North Carolina, Lori (Ed) Luker, Wilmington, Ohio, Linda (Ron) Davis, Trenton, Ohio and Lisa (Darin) Dennis, Hamilton, Ohio; two-step daughters, Holly Schmidt and Wendy Lowe; a sister, Carmella Gumbert, Troy; eight grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.
