Robert (Bob) Allen Lewis of Fairfield Township died peacefully on Monday, November 30, 2020. He was eighty-four. He was born in Cincinnati on June 14, 1936, the son of Albert James and Marie Helen (Feintheil) Lewis and attended Pleasant Ridge Presbyterian Church. Bob married Mary Stahlheber on October 30, 1993 at Coldstream Country Club, where he had been a member for many years. Bob attended Withrow high school and earned a basketball scholarship to attend DePauw University. Bob transferred to the University of Cincinnati after his freshman year to give emotional support to his mother after his father's death. He studied business and was a member of Sigma Chi. He was also in charge of organizing intramural sports, in particular basketball and tennis. Bob enrolled in a master's degree program at Xavier University majoring in economics. He was employed in sales all his life and received many awards. Bob was also a long time member of the Cincinnati Club and the Cincinnati Athletic Club. Sports remained important to him, a big basketball fan and committed golf player. He also was a fan of his daughters and made an effort to call each of them on Saturdays. When he succeeded, he said it was his lucky day. He is survived by his wife, Mary; his children, Debbie Westheimer (Dick Westheimer) of Batavia, Shari Lewis (Doug Sparks) of Milford and Laura Frank (Rainer Frank) of Gig Harbor, WA; his former wife Norma, nine grandchildren and five great grandchildren, two nephews, two nieces and a sister-in-law as well as Mary's two children, a son-in-law and grandchild.
