Robert Carl "Bob" CAWEIN, Age 85 of Hamilton, Ohio died suddenly Saturday, November 4, 2006 at Fort Hamilton Hospital after suffering a stroke, with his wife Sylvia and family by his side. He was born July 28, 1921 and was a lifelong resident of Hamilton. He was the son of Carl and Mary (Brueggan) Cawein, and graduated from Hamilton High School in 1940. Robert and Sylvia (McCool) were married on December 18, 1942 in the Presbyterian Church and enjoyed nearly 64 years together. Bob served 3½ years as a Sergeant in the Army Air Corp as a medic during World War II. He was employed at the Journal News for 46 years in the advertising department, retiring in 1986. Bob loved bicycling, boating, yard work, gardening, walking, driving his VW Bug and woodworking. He belonged to the Great Miami Bicycle Club and the Miami Indian Trekkers. Bob enjoyed a very long and active retirement - he never stopped! He was a member of the Presbyterian Church, serving as an usher, deacon, and elder and was a member of the Washington Lodge #17 F&AM, and Ft. Hamilton Chapter of Eastern Star #568. He was also a member and past president of the Hamilton Lions Club. He leaves his beloved wife, Sylvia (McCool) Cawein; one daughter, Tari Pate and her husband Michael; and one beloved grandson, Spencer Cawein Pate, of whom he was extremely proud. His family, and all who knew Bob, will miss him dearly. He was preceded in death by his father and mother, Carl and Mary (Brueggan) Cawein, his sister Reland Cawein, and his brother Richard Cawein.
