Robert H. Bernhardt age 90, Hamilton, died Sunday, August 27, 2017 at Fort Hamilton Hospital. He was born in Shenandoah, Pennsylvania on December 3, 1926, the son of Ferdinand R. and Ethel (Hepler) Bernhardt. He was a graduate of Albright College, Reading Pennsylvania with a B. S. degree in economics. Bob was a veteran of the U. S. Navy from November 28, 1944 to July 23, 1946 serving in the Atlantic Theatre. He married Patsy Cooper on September 4, 1954. He was employed for 38 years at Ohio Casualty Insurance Company retiring on January 1, 1992 as Assistant Secretary. He was a member of First United Methodist Church where he was past treasurer and usher, Muncie, Indiana Masonic Lodge, Masonic Consistory, and the Murat Shrine Temple both of Indianapolis, BPOE#93 Elks, a Kentucky Colonel and The American Legion.
