Robert J. Stocker age 89, Hamilton, died Sunday, April 29, 2018 at Fort Hamilton Hospital. He was born in Pittsburgh on November 13, 1928, the son of Herschel and Amelia (Prenter) Stocker. He was a 1946 graduate of Hamilton High School. Bob graduated from the University of Cincinnati in 1952 with a degree in engineering and received his Professional Engineering Certificate from the State of Ohio in 1960. He had been employed by AK Steel for 32 years, retiring in 1993 as Power Department Superintendent and then worked at Fernald for three years helping to make atomic waste into marbles for disposal. Bob was the 1952 Plug Horse Derby winner, a very active reader, enjoyed traveling, maintaining his tractors and was an animal lover.
