During the last few years Pete would call to check on my wife, Rosalyn, and me.

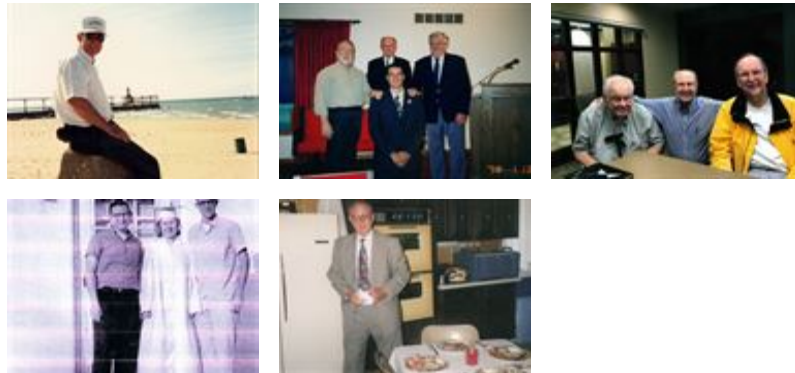
The words of II Samuel 3:38 are a fitting tribute to Pete. "A great man has fallen."
