May 21, 1928 - January 1, 2017

Ruby C. Smith age 88, died on January 1, 2017 at Hospice of Cincinnati, Hamilton Inpatient Care Center, after a brief illness. She was born in Hamilton on May 21, 1928, and was a lifelong resident. She graduated from Hamilton High School in 1946 and married her sweetheart, Robert L. Smith, on February 8, 1947. Ruby was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother, and caring for her family was her greatest source of joy. A devout Christian, she was a lifelong member and very active in the congregation of the West Side Baptist Church. 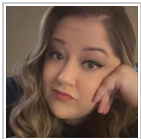
