Scott R. 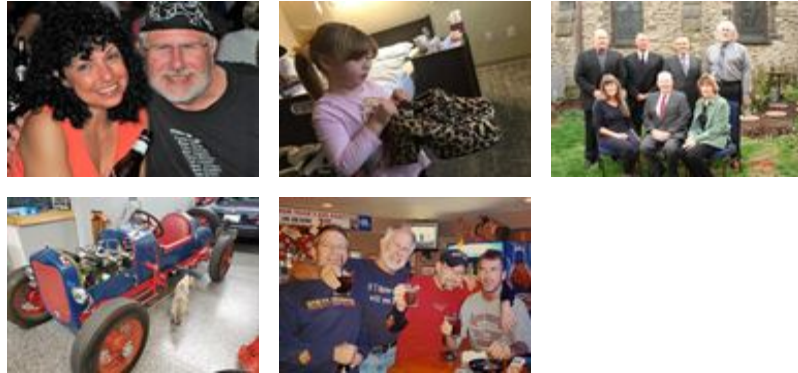
