January 22, 1936 - July 13, 2024

Sophia Kalomeres Jonson, Age 88, of Hamilton passed away Saturday, July 13, 2024 at her residence surrounded by her loving family. 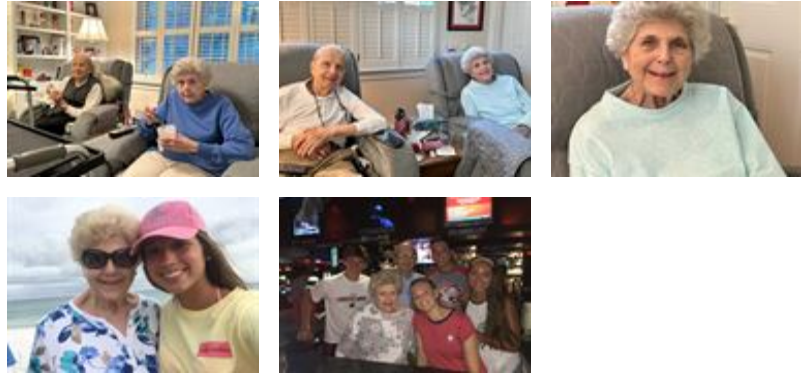

We laughed and danced as we all sang it together. Yiayia Margeory had a large needlepoint picture framed in the living room that had the words «Και αυτό θα περάσει» “And this too shall pass”. I will also always remember seeing Theia Sophie and Uncle George together at the midnight Paschal Liturgy for the celebration of Easter.
