Wanda Louise Wuest, age 80, previously of Hamilton, Ohio peacefully passed away on September 1, 2023 in The Villages, Florida. Wanda was born on November 10, 1942 to Solomon and Lucille Perkins at home on Winter Avenue in Indianapolis, Indiana. After Wanda graduated from Arsenal Tech High School she attended Ball State University. She taught school at Saint Teresa of the Little Flowers in Indianapolis before moving to Ohio. Wanda enjoyed collecting antiques. She was a member of St. Peter in Chains Catholic Church before moving to Florida. While a member of St. Peter's she created the Giving Tree program for families during the Christmas season. Wanda is survived by her loving husband Kenneth, their three daughters, their spouses, seven grandchildren, and one great grandchild.
